Tasting Notes: An elegant wine with an impressive aromatic intensity of typical Touriga Nacional fruit aromas and floral notes in perfect combination with slight nuances of vanilla. A very well-balanced wine with well-integrated tannins and a fresh acidity leading to a long and lingering finish. A wine with enormous potential to age in bottle.

Winemaking: Fermentation takes place in stainless steel vats at controlled temperature.

Aging: The wine ages in French oak barriques for a period of 12 months in which 30% of the wine ages in new oak.

Food Pairing: Enjoy this elegant, Douro Red with roast beef, game dishes and strong cheeses.
