Tasting Notes: Deep purple-black in color with a rich nose of cedar, mint and black fruit. Full-bodied and structured, the wine bursts with layers of blackberry, boysenberry and blueberry. The wine has nice intensity, highlighting rounded tannins and a spicy earth-laced finish.

Vineyards: Napa, Mendocino, Paso Robles, Sonoma

Aging: Aged 12 months in French oak, 20% new.

Food Pairing: Red meats, flavorful and heartier (red) pastas, lamb, strong-flavored cheese, and chocolates (especially dark).
